Let's find some big and small
creatures in the Museum.

**What was the smallest creature
(or animal) you found?**

**What was the biggest creature
(or animal) you found?**

Different animals, different sizes

Visit the **World Mammals (G)** and the
South Australian Biodiversity Gallery (L2).
In each one look for:

- The most enormous animal
- The tiniest animal (hint: try opening some of the drawers)
- The longest animal
- An animal that is the same height as you

Were all dinosaurs big?

**Go to the front doors of the
Discovery Centre (L1).**

Who is bigger? You or the *Hypsilophodon*?

Find the *Camerasaurus* femur. The femur is the bone in the thigh or the top part of the leg. Compare your thigh to the size of this bone! How big would you be if your thigh was as long as that? Would you fit through the door of the Museum?

Look at the *Tyrannosaurus Rex* skull!
Open your mouth as wide as you can!
Can you go as wide as the T-Rex? No?
Can you roar like
a dinosaur?

How deep is the ocean?

**Follow the giant
squid all the way
up to Level 3.** Can you be brave
and stand on the glass and
look all the way down?

Looking down, let's see how
deep some parts of the ocean can be.
Some parts are even deeper! Can you count
how many tentacles the giant squid has?
