Repatriation plays an important role in helping Australians better understand the history of Aboriginal people, it is also about the healing and truth telling of First nations people in Australia.	\$0
1	Lagos, Nigeria	<p>This workshop is result-oriented, focusing on developing practical, implementable strategies related to the development of museums and cultural interpretation and layering, collection management and repatriation related to them. The sessions are structured into problem/case study versus solutions/strategy format, where invited experts share their experiences with specific case studies, identifying specific challenges. The workshop will then collectively discuss practical strategies to deal with such issues.
